Participating in Blue Christmas at home? Here are a few things you will want to have on hand so that you can get the most out of your worship.

- 1. Set up your home altar as you would on a Sunday morning or Wednesday evening with candles, bread and wine.
- If you have an Advent Wreath, have it on your altar or near by. We will be lighting all 5 of the candles. If you don't have one, simply have 5 candles in a circle with one in the middle.
- 3. You will want to have some taper or small candles available for each person participating at your home. We will light these at the end of worship.
- 4. To participate in some of the rituals that will happen during worship have the following on hand:
 - a. Paper and somethings to write with.
 - b. Your manger or creche if you have one or a bowl.
 - c. Some heavy rocks you can hold and write on, with a sharpie and a vessel to receive the rocks.
 - d. More candles to light as a sign of hope and love.
 - e. Paper lunch bags (or something similar) and crayons/markers/paints, whatever you have on hand to create luminaries. You will also need some sort of battery operated candle (you can use real tealights as well, just be careful).
